## Luke 24:36-49

If you have ever fumbled with your house keys on a dark, snowy night, you know that although many keys may fit into the lock on your front door, only one actually unlocks this door. As Jesus appears to the gathered disciples on the night of his resurrection, he opens their minds to understand the scriptures. The disciples see clearly how Jesus is at the center of the entire Bible and how He is key to understanding all that came before Him, and all that would come after His time on Earth. Did you know?


Nearly half of the American population over age 20 has High Blood Pressure and don't even know it. Not treating high blood pressure is dangerous. It increases the risk of heart attack and stroke. It is important to check your blood pressure regularly.

St. John's is offering a free blood pressure and oxygen level check every second Sunday of the month.

If you would like your blood pressure checked, stop by the office level conference room (Room 14) between 9:00am and 9:30am on Sunday, April 14. St. John's member and nurse Chris Ries will be waiting for you.


#### **DELIVERY ANGELS**
